Memorandum of Understanding

The City of Utrecht and The City of Taichung (hereinafter referred to as "each Party" respectively and as the "Parties" collectively) hereby confirm the desire to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in order to develop a friendly and cooperative relationship.

Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of this MOU is to acknowledge that both Parties will contribute to deepening mutual understanding, exchanges and cooperation.

Article 2 (Agreement) The Parties agree to actively exchange information and cooperate with each other in fields including, but not limited to culture, innovation, intelligent transportation, trade and investment.

Article 3 (Agreement) The Parties confirm the existing declarations of intent (MoU 2016) and agree to continue to work together to strengthen and encourage collaboration between art groups, enterprises and research institutes in a number of specific areas related to culture, innovation and other fields of common interest.

Through the signing of this agreement, we aim to improve the welfare of the citizens. This agreement sets a strong foundation of mutual respect and reciprocates between both parties

This Memorandum of Understanding comes into effect from the date of its signing.

This agreement is duplicated in English and Traditional Chinese, both versions being of equal validity.
