



Memorandum of Understanding
between
HTMI Hotel & Tourism Management Institute Switzerland
and
Taichung City Government Education Bureau

This Memorandum of Understanding is designed to foster a friendly relationship through mutual cooperation in Hospitality & Culinary teaching, academic research programs and vocational teachers professional development between Taichung City Government Education Bureau and HTMI Hotel & Tourism Management Institute Switzerland . No financial obligations are assumed under this agreement.

Taichung City Government Education Bureau and HTMI Hotel & Tourism Management Institute Switzerland have reached agreement on the following areas of cooperation, subject to mutual consent and the availability of sufficient funding:

- Visiting Hospitality & Culinary Teachers Program
- Vocational Teacher Professional Development
- Special short-term academic and summer programs
- Visiting Culinary and Hospitality students internship program and study
- Student scholarship opportunities on Degree and Shorter program
- Offer Taichung City Government Education Bureau – every 10 students, 10% discount and complimentary accommodation and food for teacher

The terms of such mutual assistance and funding for any specific program and activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall commence on the date of latest signature and be in effect for three years, at which time it shall be reviewed for possible extension. Either party may terminate this Letter by written notification signed by the appropriate official of the party initiating the notice. However, such notification must be received by the other party at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.
