



Sister City Agreement Between Taichung City, Republic of China (Taiwan) and the Territory of Guam, U.S.A.

To further develop friendly cooperation and deepen mutual understanding and friendship between different cultures; Taichung City, Republic of China (Taiwan) and Territory of Guam, U.S.A. do hereby formally agree to enter into a Sister City relationship.

- I. The parties agree to jointly promote friendly exchange between the people of Taichung and Guam on the basis of equality and mutual benefit dependent upon ratification of this Agreement by both.
- II. The parties should exchange information with each other and strengthen the exchange and cooperation in economics and trade, tourism, culture, education, agriculture, medical care, the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), Sustainable Cities and other areas.
- The parties should establish a long term friendly relationship between III. Taichung and Guam on the basis of mutual exchanges and cooperation.
- IV. This Agreement is made in duplicate in both Chinese and English, with both versions being equally valid, and shall take effect from the date when it is signed by both parties.
