good friends.




One Sunny day, Marbo wanted

Dummy cried out for help. Marbo didn't know that his behavior had already abused the animal.




Then, Marbo wanted to go fishing.

He asked Dummy to take a rest and watch.


Dummy saw the fish struggling and tried to dissuade Marbo from going fishing anymore.

Dummy told him the importance of protecting the animals.






Unfortunately, Marbo ignored Dummy's advice. He still enjoyed going fishing.





Dummy left the amusement park alone when Marbo didn't pay attention to him.




From that day on, Dummy became a stray dog in the street. During Dummy's stray period, bad boys chased him and threw stone at him.
